Beacon Benefice Prayer Ministry, by Mike Campbell

Recently I was watching a programme about the Tower of London, and in particular, the ravens that live there. That reminded of a passage in Luke's gospel where Jesus talks about Ravens:

" Consider the ravens: They do not sow or reap, they have no storeroom or

barn; yet God feeds them. And how much more valuable you are than birds! "

[Luke 12;24]

Knowing how valuable we are to God means that we can pray to Him at anytime and about anything, and that nothing is too trivial to worry Him with. The trouble is, when we are concerned about something we don't always feel in the right place to pray.

So, as part of 'Prayer, Care, and Welfare' that Revd Sarah mentioned in Beacon Light a couple of weeks ago, we are introducing a new Benefice Prayer initiative. If there is something on your mind, something you are concerned or worried about, there will be a small group of dedicated Intercessors ready to offer prayer on your behalf.

Please don't think it is too petty to ask for us to pray. It may be an appointment you have, a family member, a decision you have to make, or whatever. Remember, Jesus tells us how valuable we all are to God.

Usually the phone will be answered, but if not, please leave a message and you will get a call-back fairly quickly. Once the prayer request has been received you can be confident that within a few moments there will be people praying for you.

The prayer initiative is **strictly confidential** and anything you ask us to pray about will **not** be shared with anyone other than the prayer group. It will not be put in Beacon Light, or on any of our church prayer-boards, unless you specifically ask us to do so. We would love to support you in prayer, so please don't hesitate to contact us if we can help.

In aid of St Mary's Church re-roofing project


Thank you for supporting the Cream Teas on the 16th July, it was a sociable occasion where nearly £400 was raised for the Raise the Roof Appeal.
